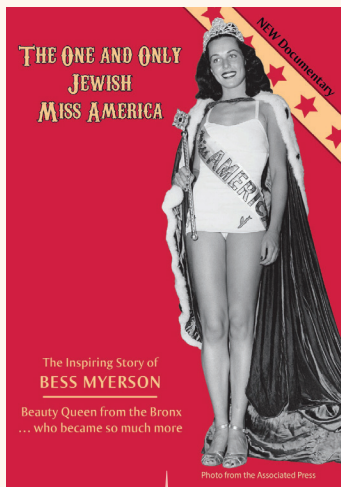


The community is invited to celebrate Jewish Women's History Month with an enlightening panel discussion of the new documentary
