Community to Honor 96 Year-Old Holocaust Survivor

Israel 'Izzy' Arbeiter: An eyewitness to the horrors of Nazi concentration camps



Holocaust survivor Israel 'Izzy' Arbeiter, 96, an eyewitness to the horrors of Nazi concentration camps, will be honored during a *virtual* community event on **October 6 at 7 pm.** The event is free and open to all.

Izzy will receive the Stephan Ross Excellence in Holocaust Education Award, named for New England Holocaust Memorial Founder and lifelong friend Stephan Ross.

This **Second Annual Tribute Event 'Voices from the Past... Lessons for the Future'** is sponsored by the New England Friends of March of the Living (NEF MOTL), and honors the enduring

impact of Israel 'Izzy' Arbeiter.' Visit https://motlnewengland.org/

March of the Living annually brings over 10,000 high schoolers from 50 countries to Poland and Israel to study the history of the Holocaust and learn about roots of anti-Semitism and prejudice. NEF MOTL provides a \$2,000 scholarship to high school juniors and seniors.
